## What

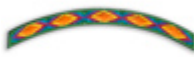

Troops split their time at the event allowing each girl time *passing it on* at her troop’s activity and *looking ahead* by visiting activities prepared by troops at the next level. There will also be a display with Bridge Ceremony ideas to help you and the girls get started with the “Plan your Bridge Ceremony” requirement. Leaders are responsible for managing permission slips and health forms for their own troop.

### “Pass It On”

Here are some ideas to get you started. **Keep it simple.** (This event is designed to lighten your load as a leader, not add to it.) Ask girls about what was special to them at their current level. What would they like to share about what they loved best?

- Display favorite camping or field trip
- Display a special service project
- Teach a favorite game or song
- Take younger scouts on a tour of Girl Scout vest
- Share a new skill learned during badge work
- Talk about earning Bronze, Silver, or Gold
- Reflect on a Girl Scout Journey

Please Note: EVERYONE bridges to the next level whether they complete the Bridge Award requirements or not. The Bridge Award is not mandatory, but completing the requirements is mandatory if girls want the pretty patch for their uniform. All Brownies bridging or “flying up” to Juniors are presented with wings. There are NO requirements for wings.
